

# Beware of Fog, Police Warn Drivers

ABU DHABI — Pamphlets containing instructions on safe driving are being distributed by Abu Dhabi Traffic Police at petrol stations on the internal roads and highways of the city.

The move is to encourage safe driving during foggy weather and to prevent accidents.

Major Ahmed Salem Al Nyadi, head of the section said the department had intensified field campaigns to raise awareness among motorists on safe driving during foggy weather, particularly at this time of the year.

The campaigns began with messages on air through radio programmes and notices in newspapers, as well as distributing pamphlets to the drivers at petrol stations, he noted. Drivers should not overtake other vehicles, change their course and not use high beam headlights because they reflect the fog and obstruct visibility, he warned.

He said motorists are advised not to use hazard lights while driving when fog gathers, and abide by traffic rules.
