

Unmarked police patrols to check on reckless motorists

Abu Dhabi: As many as 45 unmarked police cars will join forces with regular traffic patrol cars to curb reckless motorists, police announced on Tuesday.

Thirty unmarked cars will be added to fleet in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain, eight to the patrols on Mafraq area and 10 to Tarif.

“The unmarked cars will be a variety of models ranging from high end ones, including sports models and four wheel drives to low budget ones,” Ahmad Salim Niyadi of the traffic department told Gulf News.

The authorities have rented several vehicles so that residents do not recognise them. These vehicles are fitted with the devices that are found in regular patrol cars.
